Introduction

- 1. Women are among the best Christians
- 2. None more loyal than Mary Magdalene
- 3. God's ways are sometimes perplexing: v.1-10 <u>OBSERVE</u>: The real problem is our unbelief.

1. GOD'S PEOPLE OFTEN WEEP IN THIS WORLD: v.11, 13

- 1) <u>Mary weeping</u>: a lovely sight
 - (i) her Lord now "dead" angels no substitute
 - (ii) even the body "gone" love is so willing: v.15
 <u>APPLICATION</u>: A lovely example of devotion if also mixed with some ignorance too.
- 2) God's people weep when
 - they do not feel Christ near: "desertions"
 - they see His <u>cause</u> weak and low
 - few seeking <u>conversion</u>
 - Christ's <u>enemies</u> seeming to triumph <u>APPLICATION</u>: No wonder we weep <u>today</u> in this land!

2. WE NEVER KNOW HOW NEAR COMFORT IS: v.16

- 1) A strange <u>confession</u>! v.14-15. It is like the two on the way to Emmaus!
- 2) Comfort was <u>at hand</u> but unrecognized:
 - **Q.** Why did Christ let Mary weep?
 - $\underline{\mathbf{A}}$. (i) to show her <u>love</u> which He delights in
 - (ii) to <u>comfort</u> her no comfort like this!
 - OBSERVE: Christ loves to draw out our love.
 - So <u>Peter</u>: "Lovest thou me?"

 No comfort is like <u>Christ's presence</u> to those who value him: "<u>Rabboni</u>" <u>APPLICATION</u>: Does your soul say "Rabboni" to Christ? It is proof that you love Him.

3. <u>THE BEST IS YET TO BE FOR GOD'S PEOPLE</u>: v.17

- "<u>Touch me not...</u>":v.17. Explain

 a point of doctrine
 - (i) a point of doc (ii) of practice
- 2) Christ's work was <u>not yet complete</u>:
 - (i) His humiliation now over
 - (ii) His exaltation also needed
- 3) What is <u>Christ doing</u> for us <u>now</u>?
 - (i) as <u>prophet</u>: "Go, teach all nations..."
 - (ii) as <u>priest</u>: "sprinkle many nations"
 - (iii) as King: "the kingdoms of the world..."
- 4) The <u>climax</u> at last: "to prepare a place"
 <u>APPLICATION</u>: Believer, He is in heaven preparing you for glory and glory for you!

4. WOMEN TOO MUST SPREAD THE GOSPEL: v.18

- See <u>Mary's mission</u> here: v.18

 her excitement: "Not dead!"
 "He is going to God for us!"
- 2) Do not discourage women from <u>lawful service</u> to Christ: - the case of Apollos
 - the case of Phoebe
- 3) What is not allowed is <u>public preaching</u> to a mixed congregation (1 Tim. 2)
 But they must witness privately: e.g. The woman of Samaria.

CONCLUSION

We need more witnessing today to Christ: "Go to my brethren..." We have the best message in all the world."
