Introduction

- 1. Christ here preaches to his people
- 2. Various evils: hypocrisy / covetousness...
- 3. Here: anxiety or worry

<u>OBSERVE</u>: We as Christians must learn to live in this world without anxiety: TEXT

1. WHAT IS ANXIETY OR WORRY?

- 1) One of the many trials in this world: v.34
- 2) We must live
 - (i) responsibly
 - (ii) in an ordered and disciplined way
 - (iii) keeping God's Law
- 3) But not to <u>allow FEAR</u> to settle on our mind:
 - (i) "<u>Taking thought</u>" (v.25, 27, 28, 31, 34)
 - (ii) **Illustration**: "add one cubit"! Folly.
 - (iii) "Buried in thought" an obsession

OBSERVE: Worry is a killer – a destroyer:

ILLUSTRATION: a lady who "fell silent"

- 4) It is all too easy to <u>fall into worry</u>:
 - (i) "for your <u>life</u>": v.25. So many do they are in perpetual worry.
 - (ii) it is worldliness: v.32
 - (iii) food, drink, clothes anything.

<u>DEFINITION</u>: That sickness of the mind by which we allow our minds to be darkened by fears of one kind or another.

2. WHEN WORRY STRIKES US, WHAT DO WE DO?

- 1) Tell yourself, God <u>never</u> commands worry: "Be careful for nothing".
- 2) Worry arises from <u>unbelief</u> so we need to remind ourselves of God's Word.
- 3) God never forsakes His people in the trials of life His promises are always true: Isaiah 43:1-3
- 4) When worry strikes you, go on your knees to seek God's face: **ILLUSTRATION**: Hezekiah, Daniel, Paul
- 5) God is greater than all our problems and He has the answers to problems great and small:ILLUSTRATION: the printer which jammed.
- 6) God has <u>promised</u> to supply all our needs: <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: I to Dumfries years ago
- 7) Do not be afraid of your <u>enemies</u> or those who seek to do you harm: "In nothing terrified...", said Paul.

CONCLUSION

- 1. Take away your fears for yesterday and fears for tomorrow what is there left?
- 2. "Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof" one step at a time.
- 3. Who had such menacing cares as Christ?
