**APPLICATION**: It is amazing where you find faith!  
(A soldier – a Roman – of a lordly nation)

**2. THE GREAT IMPORTANCE OF FAITH (IN PRAYER)**

- 1) What is the greatest factor in prayer?
  - (i) NOT eloquence;
  - (ii) NOT memory;
  - (iii) BUT faith
- 2) I think this is what we all need most to improve our prayers – mine too! It is to have more faith!
- 3) Let me prove the point:
  - (i) The fig-tree (Matthew 21): see v.21-22

- (ii) Peter on the sea (Matthew 14): see v.31
- (iii) The lunatic son (Matthew 17): see v.20
- (iv) James 1:5-8: see v.6
- (v) Hebrews 11:6: "without faith..."
- (vi) Romans 1:17: "the just shall live by faith"  
**APPLICATION**: Do we pray with faith?

**3. THIS PRINCIPLE IS ILLUSTRATED ALL THROUGH THE BIBLE**

- 1) I refer to the importance of faith
- 2) Look at the cases:
  - (i) Abel's sacrifice
  - (ii) Enoch's translation
  - (iii) Abraham's prayer for Sodom
  - (iv) Jacob wrestling with the angel
  - (v) Joshua – the sun stood still
  - (vi) Samson: the Temple fell
  - (vii) David v. Goliath
- 3) Many others, also, e.g. Daniel
- 4) Let us seek to excel in faith – now what have we prayed for – let us look for answers to these prayers
