1. <u>A SURVEY OF THE LIFE OF JOHN THE BAPTIST</u>

- 1) John was the subject of O. T. prophecy
- 2) John had a remarkable <u>birth</u>
- 3) John had a powerful <u>ministry</u>
- 4) John had a very high <u>Commendation</u> from <u>Christ</u>
- 5) John was <u>faithful</u> and suffered for it <u>APPLICATION</u>: Learn from John what God approves

2. JOHN WELL UNDERSTOOD HIS PLACE IN THE PURPOSES OF GOD

- <u>TEXT</u>: As Christ rose, so John must fall.
 <u>DOCTRINE</u>: We must understand our place and be content to accept it.
- 2) The apparent <u>perplexity</u> of John in prison
- 3) The different ministries of John and Christ both rejected by men.

4) <u>Lessons</u>:

- (i) Honour God for His wisdom
- (ii) Do not compare ministers

3. JOHN'S SIGHT OF HIS "DECREASE" FULFILLED

- 1) It consisted especially of these <u>events</u>:
 - (i) his imprisonment
 - (ii) his <u>death</u>
- 2) John's death <u>haunted</u> Herod later his conscience suffered for it.
- 3) John and Christ were closely <u>connected</u>:
 - (i) by blood relationship
 - (ii) by their ministries
 - (iii) by the manner of their deaths
- 4) Lessons:
 - (i) one evidence of a servant of Christ is to be <u>badly treated</u> <u>APPLICATION</u>: Do not be surprised if it is to be <u>your</u> experience
 - (ii) we must be grateful for the <u>service</u> God is pleased to give us: John's differed from Christ's.
