Sermon ID - 2144 PRAYER MEETING "<u>A JEALOUS GOD</u>"

Introduction

- 1. We have this statement: 'jealous'
- 2. It is found at least <u>6 times</u> in OT
- 3. Do we think of it? Very <u>important</u> to know.

1. GOD IS JEALOUS OF HIS OWN WORSHIP

- 1) <u>Repeatedly</u> this word is used "Jealous"
- 2) There are <u>2 sorts</u> of Jealousy:
 - (i) <u>evil</u>: resentment at the talents, etc. of others: <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Saul of David – "very angry" (1 Sam. 18:8) <u>DEFINITION</u>: That sinful anger which springs from <u>envy</u> <u>OBSERVATION</u>: This is never in <u>God</u> – nor could it be. Explain
 - (ii) <u>good</u>: insistence on what is right and <u>holy</u>
 <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: a husband of his wife's love
 a parent that their children be obedient
- 3) God insists on everything good, esp. His worship:
 - (i) it is a great sin <u>NOT</u> to worship God
 - (ii) it is a great sin to worship any other "God"
 - (iii) it is a great sin to worship God <u>falsely</u>
- 4) <u>Proofs</u>: TEXT: Exodus 34:14; Deut. 4:24 ; Joshua 24:19 <u>APPLICATION</u>: Take great care over God's <u>worship</u>

2. GOD IS JEALOUS FOR HIS OWN GODHOOD

- 1) This is <u>clear</u> from the refs.: Deut 4:24 and TEXT:
 - (i) God is and He will suffer no pretended <u>rivals</u>
 - (ii) Neither gods of the <u>mind</u>, nor material <u>idols</u>

- 2) God <u>insists</u> that we know Him for what He is:
 - (i) the divine <u>essence</u> is one
 - (ii) the divine <u>persons</u> are three
 - (iii) the divine <u>attributes</u> given in scripture:
 - incommunicable
 - communicable
 <u>OBSERVE</u>: God will have us so <u>think</u> of Him and so worship Him.
- 3) The OT as a whole reveals God's jealousy:
 - (i) The Tower of <u>Babel</u>
 - (ii) The Golden \underline{Calf}
 - (iii) The error of the <u>Canaanites</u> "Baal"
 - (iv) The folly of <u>Jeroboam I</u>
 - (v) and of the <u>heathen</u> nations of old
- 4) This visible in Isaiah 44: God's <u>sarcasm</u> at the folly of idolatry! <u>OBSERVATION</u>: God will <u>punish</u> us if we worship in any false way: TEXT <u>APPLICATION</u>: Treat God and His worship with <u>care</u>

3. GOD IS JEALOUS FOR HIS PEOPLE'S LOVE

- 1) This is something we need to see <u>clearly</u>:
 - (i) it is <u>wonderful</u>: Deism
 - (ii) the <u>greatness</u> of God
 - (iii) the <u>smallness</u> of man <u>ILLUSTRATION</u>: Does a mighty Emperor care if a few beggars hate him? But <u>God</u> does!
- 2) This is because of God's <u>love</u>:
 - (i) He desires us to love Him
 - (ii) He has taken <u>steps</u> to lead us to do so <u>OBSERVATION</u>: God so desires our love that He has gone to immense <u>lengths</u>: John 3:16
- 3) What <u>love</u> God has for us all!
 - (i) "<u>Come</u> unto <u>me</u>..."
 - (ii) "Look unto me..."
 - (iii) "Thou shalt <u>love</u>..." (The <u>first</u> commandment)

CONCLUSION

We <u>must</u> love this great God
 If we do not, we must expect to be <u>punished</u> – "jealous".
